Title of Dissertation: Prevalence, Assessment of knowledge and QOL about Gynaecological Morbidities.

My dissertation topic was related to Gynaecological morbidities. Females of different age groups enrolled in the study. These were main objectives: (1) To study prevalence pattern of Gynaecological morbidities among school girls, college girls and community women. (2) To assess knowledge of females regarding menstruation, hygiene- practice, Lifestyle modification, PMS. (3) To study QOL during menses. (4) To study menarche age. (5) To provide awareness to female regarding menstrual hygiene management. Total **1754 subjects** were directly or indirectly enrolled in study and all work was satisfactorily completed.
